Bear Claw Leadership Conference

- **Who:** At least First Class Scouts who have completed Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops (ILST)
- **What:** Youth-run event that strives to introduce a variety of skills to the participant's leadership toolkit through the scouting principles of a youth-led, patrol-based environment. It is designed to help units bridge the training continuum between the Introduction to Leadership Skills (ILS) series and the Council-led National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT/IMPEESA). Includes a Patrol Leader track and a Senior Patrol Leader track. Both tracks cover six leadership traits: Communications, Knowing and Using Resources, Planning, Representing the Group, Understanding the Characteristics and Needs of the Group and Its Members, and Leading by Example.
